L.A. Log Reading

We read Go Away Otto in our anthology, and worked on making predictions while reading. This story was about a little boy who wants to help. Writing

We spent the week writing an expository about a season. The kids wrote webs on Monday writing facts about the season that they chose, such a weather in that season, clothes they wear in that season, activities to do, and characteristics about that season. Students wrote their paragraphs on Thursday. We have been focusing on starting each of our sentences differently.
