L.A. Log Reading

We read *Dog School* in our anthology, and worked on making predictions. I will be listening to the children read one-on-one in the next week and adjusting guided reading groups again. Some children are making significant gains and I am so proud of them. Please remind your children to read the books to you at night. Students have been identifying sight words as well this week. Please make sure you are practicing the sight words that your child doesn't know.

Writing

We spent the week writing a paragraph about what we are thankful for.
