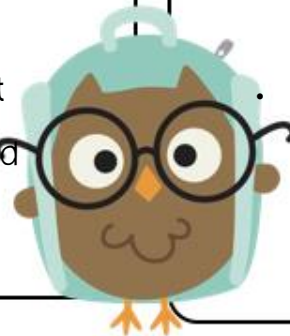

### L.A. Log Reading
