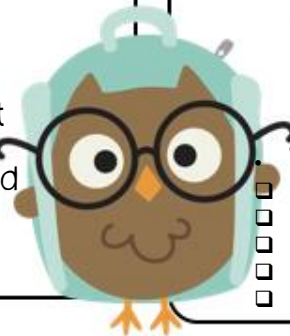

### L.A. Log Reading

This week we read the story Johnny Appleseed. This was a nonfiction story about who Johnny Appleseed was and what he did. Keep encouraging your child to read at home because the more practice they get, the better their reading will become. I have so many students that have turned in a bunch of reading logs. Keep up the great work! Students need 5 reading logs turned in by the end of the year. Please make sure you are practicing the sight words that your child doesn't know each night. The students should know how to read all of the sight words that we have introduced.

### Writing

The students read nonfiction books about their animals to do research about their animals characteristics. On Monday, the students created an organizer with their facts about their animals to use for their final paragraphs on Thursday.
