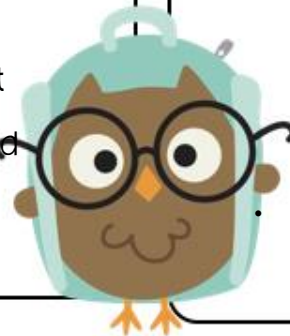
Writing
