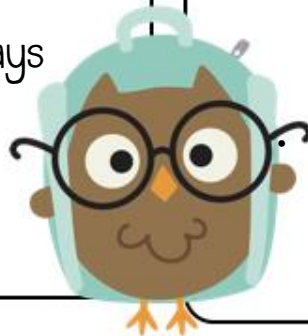
Writing
