1. Chandra went to the bakery for his mother. He bought one dozen small cookies and five large cookies. How many more small cookies than large cookies did Chandra buy?	2. The baker sold five cupcakes, six muffins, and nine rolls to Gideon. How many treats did Gideon buy?
3. Cylan asked 8 friends "Do you want chicken soup, tomato soup, or pea soup?" Half wanted chicken soup, a fourth wanted tomato soup, and the rest wanted pea soup. How many wanted each kind of soup?	4. If one cookie costs five cents how many cookies can Ihsan buy with a quarter?
5. Dakari had eight cookies. He gave a fourth of the cookies to Ella. How many cookies did he have left?	6. A cookie costs 5 cents, a muffin costs 10 cents, and a tart costs 30 cents. What can Isabella buy if she has a dime and six pennies? How many cookies can she buy with six nickels?
7. Gabrielle likes pickles a lot. Yesterday she ate 3 dill pickles, 4 sweet pickles, and 3 bread and butter pickles. Today she ate twice as many pickles. How many pickles did Gabrielle eat today?	8. Jaiden and his friends wanted popcorn after school. Mom made 15 cups of popcorn. The boys ate 6 cups. Mom spilled 3 cups. How many cups of popcorn were left?
9. Jameson had 12 peanuts. He gave a third of the peanuts to Jaxon. How many peanuts did he give to Jaxon?	10. Jaxon's Boy Scout troop ate sandwiches after their meeting. Each sandwich had 2 slices of bread. How many slices of bread did it take to make 9 sandwiches?
