Please choose 8 problems to solve for math homework this month. Attach drawings to the calendar when you return it at the end of the month!

<p>1. Santiago and Theresa go to a small school. There are only 2 classrooms in the small school. There are 10 students in Santiago's class and 18 students in Theresa's class.</p> <p>How many children go to this school in all? How many more children are in Theresa's class than Santiago's?</p>	<p>2. Peyton put 6 nickels in her piggy bank. Scarlet put 8 nickels in her piggy bank. How much did each child save? How much more did Scarlet save than Peyton?</p>
<p>3. Trenton took 15 cents from his bank. He spent 9 cents. How much money does he have left?</p>	<p>4. Shivangi saved 10 cents every day for a week. How much money did she save?</p>
<p>5. Wyatt put 2 nickels and 3 dimes in his piggy bank. How much money did he save?</p>	<p>6. Wyatt's mom made 18 peanut butter sandwiches and 12 jelly sandwiches for the picnic. 9 peanut butter sandwiches were eaten. How many peanut butter sandwiches were left?</p>
<p>7. The picnic lasted three hours. If it started at 2:00, at what time did it end?</p>	<p>8. Each of the seven dwarfs ate 2 cookies. Each of the three bears ate 2 brownies. How many more cookies were eaten than brownies?</p>
