- 1. Pickles are 60 cents, popcorn is 30 cents, peanuts are 70 cents, and pretzels are 50 cents. Kelsey wanted a snack. She went to the store to buy something. She looked at what things cost. She had 90 cents. She bought 2 snacks. What did she buy?
- 2. A funny car stopped in the circus ring. Out came a dozen clowns. Four of the clowns were tall. The rest were short. How many short clowns were there?
- 3. Khloe the clown has many trained animals. She has 20 dogs, 12 cats, and 26 mice. How many animals does Khloe have in all?
- 4. Jonathan and Kaylana went to the circus to see the clowns. The show started at 2:30. It lasted 3 hours. At what time was the show over?
- 5. Ringmaster Marli measured the clowns in her circus. The tallest clown was 76 inches tall. The shortest clown was 54 inches tall. How much taller was the tallest clown than the shortest clown?
- 6. Liam had 24 blue kites, 22 red kites, and 14 orange kites for sale. How many kites did he have for sale?
- 7. Fifteen children took kites to the park. Nine of the children were boys. How many girls took kites to the park?
- 8. Lucas took his kite to the park at 3:00. He had to be home in an hour and a half. At what time did he have to be home?
- 9. The teacher let the kids bring their pets to school. Miles brought his pet snake. When he got the snake it was 12 inches long, and now it is 32 inches long. How much has the snake grown?
- 10. Mani brought her cats Fluffy and Samson. Mani is seven years old. Fluffy is six years old. Samson is nine years older than Fluffy. How old is Samson?

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
