<p>1. Jaxon has 13 cents. Which item can he buy? How much change will he have left?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Stamp for 15 cents</li><li>• Pen for 25 cents</li><li>• Notebook for 11 cents</li></ul>	<p>2. Ihsan has 12 marbles in his pocket. His pocket has a hole in it. First he lost 3 marbles at the playground. Then he lost 2 more at school. Write 2 number sentences to show how to solve this.</p>
<p>3. Kelsey is cutting sandwiches into fourths. She cuts 3 sandwiches. How many equal pieces does she have? Show your answer.</p>	<p>4. Isabella has a dime. Jaiden has two more dimes than Isabella. Jaxon has one more dime than Isabella. How many dimes does Jaxon have? How much money is this?</p>
<p>5. Khloe has 4 more stickers than Marli. Together they have 10. How many stickers does Khloe have? Guess and then check.</p>	<p>6. Kaylana went to a party at 3:00. She stayed for two and a half hours. What time did she leave? Draw the clock.</p>
<p>7. Marli wants to know how long her couch is. She doesn't have a ruler. She decides to use her foot to see how many shoes long it is. Use your shoe/foot to measure how long your couch is.</p>	<p>8. Which group of coins does not belong? Add each set of coins.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 2 nickels and 2 dimes</li><li>• 1 nickel and 1 quarter</li><li>• 5 pennies and 5 nickels</li><li>• 5 pennies and 3 dimes</li><li>• 10 pennies, 2 nickels, and 1 dime</li></ul>
