Please choose 5 problems to solve for math homework this month. Attach drawings to the calendar when you return it at the end of the month!

1. Brielle has 2 more stamps than Chandra. Cylan has 1 fewer stamp than Chandra. Chandra has 7 stamps. How many stamps does Brielle have? How many stamps does Cylan have?	2. There were 8 children playing. 2 children went home. Azariah says there were 10 children left. Bertina says there were 6. Who is right? How do you know?
3. Dakari read a lot of books this month. He read more than 17 books. He read fewer than 21 books. How many books could Dakari have read?	4. Cici lost 3 marbles. Now she has 6. How many marbles did she have before?
5. There is a line of 5 chairs. Ella is sitting in the first chair. Gabrielle is sitting 2 seats behind him. Is Gabrielle sitting in the first, second, or third chair?	6. Ellie has 2 nickels and 2 pennies. Emily has 2 pennies and 1 dime. Who has more money? Who has more coins?
7. Jameson is thinking of a number. If you subtract 6 from that number, you get a number that is the same as $4 + 5$ . What number is he thinking of?	8. Gideon has 2 pieces of wire. One piece is 24 inches long, and the other piece is 12 inches long. Does he have more or less than 30 inches? How much more or less?
